- No sharing of kit, players are expected to have their own kit at all times.
- Hand sanitizers to be made available for all players (including opposition) at all times in the clubhouse. The first aid kit needs to be renewed in case it hasn't been in a long time
- No using saliva/sweat to shine the ball. Ideally, one person needs to be in charge of shining the ball throughout the innings.
- The umpire needs to be in possession of a hand sanitizer that players can use on the field. It recommended to use it every 30 minutes for all players and after every over for the bowlers
- Limit as far as possible the huddles and hugs.
- Players are expected to bring their own food. Food/utensils sharing needs to be avoided as much as possible. So basically, no teas.
- Players are expected to have their own bottles of water/drinks. No sharing of jugs/glasses.
- Maintain a distance of 1m between individuals as far as possible.
- If any player develops symptoms/tests positive within 14 days of the game, he/she should immediately inform the club about this.
- The pavilion is out of bounds for changing.
- Access to pavilion is limited and managed by the Covid and Match manager.
- All umpires are to wear gloves and masks, means of counting balls are not allowed to be shared.
- Scorers and those manipulating the scoreboard are required to wear gloves.
- Two metre distance between all chairs.
- Only gloved hands allowed to replace, stumps/bails during play. Covid/Match manager to put out and take in wickets.
