

General Rules for the use of the swimming Pool

1. The Pool will be open from mid-May to end-September.

2. Opening dates and days when there is a life-guard:

From mid-May to mid-July and from the last week in August until the end of September

Wednesday: 12h15- 18h

Saturday : 12h15- 18h

Sunday: 12h15- 18h

3. The use of the pools is at your own risk.

Think of others, we all want to enjoy it and live in harmony.

Children under 11 years are not permitted to enter the precincts of the pool without an adult over 18 years.

Safety and supervision of children is the responsibility of parents.

The following are prohibited in the pool area :

- Running on the edges, jumping, diving and staying underwater.
- Smoking.
- Eating and drinking except from plastic water bottles. (To avoid attracting wasps, a real scourge.)
- To leave or throw away papers, objects or waste of any kind.
- Animals, even on a lead.
- Playing with balls or ball games and generally annoying club members by dangerous games or actions, noisy or inappropriate behaviour.
- Use offensive language or otherwise commit acts likely to annoy users and compromise the reputation or the operation of the Club.
- The use of large floats (boats, air mattresses, etc.,...) is not allowed. Only rings and children's flotation devices (water wings) are allowed.

5. The small pool is only open to children under 6 years under the supervision of their parents.

6. For reasons of hygiene, showering before using the pools is mandatory.

7. From 25 May to 20 July and from 21 August to 29 September 2013, the ponds are monitored by qualified personnel (BEESAN and / or BNSSA) on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays from 12:15 to 18:00, in accordance with regulations.

8. Standard Athletic Club declines any responsibility in case of theft, loss, and/or partial or total destruction of all personal items, jewelry, smartphones, all kinds of clothes, shoes, bags etc., which may be left in pool area.

9. Users must wear an appropriate swimming costume.

10. Users are required to comply with the requirements or instructions that may be given to them by the pool staff, who are authorized to take any and all measures and sanctions as may be necessary against offenders. (Warnings, short or long term expulsions, etc.)

11 . The Standard Athletic Club may only be held responsible during pool opening hours (see the P.O.S.S.) and only with respect to users who are in compliance with this present Regulation.

12 . The Management of the Standard Athletic Club and the pool staff are responsible for the implementation of this Regulation .

13 . This rules is part of the Plan for Organizing Help and Surveillance (P.O.S.S.) implemented in this property. This plan is available on request. An excerpt is displayed.
